Description of Current Situation: Redmond Learning Community Middle School Enrollment and Projections

The chart below shows enrollment for Middle Schools in the Redmond Learning Community. Voters passed a bond in April 2016 which will allow the district to build a new Middle School to open in Fall 2019 The new middle school will add 900 students in enrollment capacity.

Projected enrollment is determined by taking current students from the elementary feeder school and current middle school students, moving them ahead a grade in future years and adding in students from known future developments and expected growth.
